

FINAL FIELD ANNOUNCED FOR THE SECOND ANNUAL ASCENSION CHARITY CLASSIC PRESENTED BY EMERSON

Elite field includes eight of the top-10 in the Charles Schwab Cup, 21 PGA TOUR Champions major championship title holders and four World Golf Hall of Fame members

ST. LOUIS (September 2, 2022) - Tournament officials announced today the final field for the second annual Ascension Charity Classic presented by Emerson at Norwood Hills Country Club in St. Louis, Mo. scheduled for next week, Sept. 5 - 11. This elite roster of 78* players collectively represent 226 PGA TOUR Champions victories, including 21 senior major championship titles.

The field also contains 14 PGA TOUR major championship wins and four World Golf Hall of Fame members, including Ernie Els, Bernhard Langer, Collin Montgomerie, and José María Olazábal. Eight of the top-10 players in the Charles Schwab Cup ranking are represented, including four of the top-5: Steven Alker (No.1), Padraig Harrington (No.2), Jerry Kelly (No.3), and last week's winner on PGA TOUR Champions Steve Stricker (No. 5). Stricker and Harrington will both be making their first starts at next week's Ascension Charity Classic. Since Harrington's PGA TOUR Champions debut last October, the Irishman has racked up eight top-5 finishes over 12 starts, including two wins and four runner-up efforts.

The world-class field also features the current Senior Open Championship winner Darren Clarke, PGA TOUR Champions reigning Rookie of the Year Jim Furyk, defending Ascension Charity Classic champion David Toms, Masters winner Mike Weir, fan favorite John Daly, and Ascension Ambassadors St. Louis native Jay Williamson, PGA TOUR Champions rookies Justin Leonard and David Duval, and 2022 Payne Stewart Award winner Billy Andrade.

Tickets for the tournament can be purchased at ascensioncharityclassic.com. Two types of weekly admission options are available, a Clubhouse Ticket as well as a Grounds Ticket. Daily tickets are also offered. Tickets start at \$20, and kids 16 and under can attend for free with a ticketed adult.
